ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES 16-18 JULY 2019

On Tuesday 16, Wednesday 17 and Thursday 18 July 2019 we are suspending the normal school timetable and offering a wide range of activities both in and out of school. This offers an opportunity for students to extend their learning in a particular area of interest or even try something completely new.

It must be stressed that these are compulsory days of education and attendance on a course is expected.

Students should make their choice and return the form at the back of the booklet to Helen Radford with their non-refundable deposit as detailed in the activity description. We need to ensure that all activities will be financially viable before we make any payments on behalf of our students to confirm the bookings, hence the need for a non-refundable deposit.

Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis on receipt of the non-refundable deposit in full (or an explanatory note if it is not possible for you to enclose it at this time).

Further information including any additional payment dates will be provided by the activity leaders when all details have been confirmed.

Students who fail to make a final choice will be allocated to a programme of free school-based activities.

The approximate cost of each course is shown in the details, and students will be able to pay by instalments. If your child is currently eligible for Pupil Premium (Free school meals currently or in the last 6 years, services children, students in care or adopted from care) and wish to access possible support towards payment, please complete the reverse of the Student Choices Form. Pupil Premium support must be agreed at the time of sign-up for the trip activity. Please note that Pupil Premium Support cannot be guaranteed.

The school reserves the right to alter or cancel activities that are not financially viable, withdraw students on behavioural grounds or withdraw students for non-payment if this has not been discussed and agreed with school.

<p>1. A Load of Balls Years 8-12</p> <p>Maximum number of students: 44</p>	<p>Cost – Approx £55 Non-residential</p> <p>Deposit required: £20</p>
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Over the three days students will have the opportunity to have a go at the following activities:

Visit Willows Sports Centre and get ready for **Laser Quest** and **5-A-Side Football**.

Go Extreme!!! At Wild Park Leisure and enjoy several games of **Paintballing**.

Relax a little at the Q Club and enjoy **Pool, Darts and Snooker**.

<p>2. Barcelona Years 8-9</p> <p>Maximum number of students: 30</p>	<p>Cost – £560 Residential</p> <p>Initial payment required: £390</p>
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This activity has been advertised to students in school already. At the time of printing this booklet, there are 4 spaces available.

The visit will be a four day, three night visits on a full board basis, flying from a UK airport and staying at a Costa Brava hotel.

We will visit the city of Barcelona, including the Cathedral and other cultural sights and tourist areas. We will also visit the famous Port Aventura Theme Park for a day.

<p>3. Fun Food Tours Years 8-10</p> <p>Maximum number of students: 40</p>	<p>Cost – Approx £195 Residential</p> <p>Deposit required: £50</p>
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We will travel to London by coach and stay in London for two nights in Bed & Breakfast accommodation. Included in our stay will be a tour of a 4 star hotel, evening meal at Pizza Express and a guided tour of the famous Borough Market or Billingsgate Market.

Other activities which we hope to include will be a visit to the National History Museum, Hyde Park Gardens & Sky Garden (a unique public space that spans three storeys and offers 360 degree uninterrupted views across the City of London).

We also hope to visit Camden market and include some time for sightseeing and shopping.

<p>4. Ing Years 8-10</p> <p>Maximum number of students: 48</p>	<p>Cost – Approx £90 Non-residential</p> <p>Deposit required: £30</p>
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Three days of activities trying something exciting.

- Rollercoasting at Alton Towers (late return to school)
- Go Karting at Midland Karting – Team Racing at
- Cycling, sailing and splashing session at Carsington Water

5. London Theatre Trip

Years 9-12

Cost – Approx £210

Part-residential

Maximum number of students: 40

Deposit required: £50

We will travel by coach and hopefully visit the British Museum on arrival in London.

Our time in the capital will then be spent seeing "Wicked" and "The Play that Goes Wrong" with an all you can eat pizza meal too!

There will be short walking tour, shopping time in the Covent Garden Piazza and an overnight stay with an all you can eat breakfast.

The third day will be based in school with fun activities/workshops.

6. Netherlands Trip

Years 8-10

Cost – Approx £340

Residential

Maximum number of students: 44*

Deposit required: £120

Students will be off on an overseas residential for 3 nights to The Netherlands. We will stay in a hotel on the outskirts of the capital, Amsterdam, and over the space of 3 days, we will visit the historic city of Amsterdam, visiting various museums and a canal boat tour of the city. We will also visit Walibi Holland Theme Park. Students will be given some free time to purchase items and gifts on the trip.

7. Painting a Canvas

Years 8-9

Maximum number of students: 20

Cost - Free

School based activity

Deposit required: None

Experimenting with painting techniques to produce a piece on canvas.

8. School of Rock

Years 8-12

Maximum number of students: 25

Cost - Free

School based activity

Deposit required: None

For those about to rock!

Participants will learn how to put together a band, write songs and perform and record material.

If in doubt, watch the film!

9. Snowboarding at the Snowdome
Years 8-10

Maximum number of students: 36

Cost - £120

Non-residential

Deposit required: £30

Start from scratch or improve your skills.

We have hired the Snowdome and six of its finest snowboard instructors for three days of snow filled antics. Coach travel to and from school is included. (7.30am departure from Belper School).

If you have never experienced the thrills of snowboarding before, now is the time to begin. There will be a two hour session each day with full equipment and instruction provided. If you 'really go for it' you should be able to progress to 'recreational standard' – so you can go off on your own without an instructor by the end of day three. If you are an existing boarder with some skills already under your belt, we will have instructors waiting to move you on to the next level. Jumps and tricks or improved turning techniques could be your focus for development.

<p>10. Sports Galore Years 8-10</p> <p>Maximum number of students: 60</p>	<p>Cost - Free School based activity</p> <p>Deposit required: None</p>
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Play sports all day everyday on the 'Sports Galore' enrichment activity.

At the start of each day, we will work out a programme with a wide variety of activities for the day ahead including competitions.

Students will get to choose which activity they do.

Activities and competitions might include..... football, tennis, badminton, rounders, volleyball, table tennis, basketball, handball, cricket, softball, squash, swimming, water polo – whatever you want really – you decide!

<p>11. What no lessons? Years 8-9</p> <p>No maximum number of students</p>	<p>Cost - Free School based activity</p> <p>Deposit required: None</p>
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A programme of school based activities.

Details are still to be finalised when numbers are known, but the range of activities are likely to include sport and exciting workshops in subjects such as Science, Drama, Computing, Technology etc.
