

Music Department – Homework Procedure Document

Key Stage 3

Homework will be set when required and relevant for the topics being studied in the classroom. Due to the practical nature of the course it is not possible to set homework every week but work such as research based presentations or learning homework may be set. These will be recorded in the student's planner in line with the school policy.

Key Stage 4

There will be a variety of homework set throughout the course of the BTEC study. This may range from research, managing class notes, preparing coursework submissions etc. It may also be necessary for students to practise their performance work should they be following this style of unit. The homework will be recorded in the planner in line with school policy. The modules students choose varies and the manner of homework required will reflect this.

Key Stage 5

Students can expect homework regularly during the course; the style of homework will be similar to that in Key Stage 4 and will include research, managing class notes, preparing coursework submissions, practise for performance work etc. The modules students choose varies and the manner of homework required will reflect this.

Marking of homework in all key stages will be carried out in line with the school's marking and assessment policy.
