Opportunities for access

Mid-year Tutor Review and Opportunity Providers Exhibition. This is an annual event held around February. All students from Years 7-13 are invited into school with parents to discuss their progress across the curriculum. Local providers of education and apprenticeships can apply to exhibit and talk to parents and students about the full range of academic and technical pathways, including apprenticeships, Further Education and Higher Education opportunities.

The School Careers Programme details a number of other events which might also offer providers opportunities to come into school to speak to pupils and/or their parents/carers. Additionally, the school keeps a database of providers who have worked with us in the past or who would like to do so in the future. Please contact our Careers Leader to be included on this database and identify the most suitable opportunities for you.

All requests will be considered based on staff availability to support the activity, clashes with other planned activity, trips or visits to the school, interruption to preparation for examinations and rooming or space availability to host the activity.

Premises and facilities

The school will make available suitable spaces for discussions between the provider and students as appropriate to the activity. The school will also consider making available AV and other specialist equipment to support provider presentations. This will all be discussed and agreed in advance of the visit with the Careers Leader or another relevant member of the school staff.

Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their prospectus or other relevant course literature at the School Reception for placing in the school Careers Resource Centre. This is managed by the Careers Leader and is available to all students at lunch, break times and after school.
