- Year 9 Options Evening. This is an annual event held in the early Spring term. Students
  from year 9 are invited into school with parents to discuss their progress across the

  examinations and rooming or space availability to host the activity.

This will all be discussed and agreed in advance of the visit with the Careers Leader or another relevant member of the school staff.
