

Belper School Sixth Form Entry Criteria 2026-2028

All candidates are expected to have achieved a minimum of 5 GCSEs at grades 4-9 including GCSE mathematics and GCSE English Language or Literature. There are also subject specific requirements as detailed below. We have these entry requirements to ensure that students can thrive in their chosen subjects and they allow classes to study the curriculum content in depth. Students choose three A levels or a course that is equivalent. In some cases four subjects may be considered, if a student chooses Core Maths or Further Maths.

In addition to our academic entry criteria, students should be able to demonstrate that they are able to commit to study at this level and make a positive contribution to Belper School Sixth Form.
